GENERAL AND SPECIAL FEES

Due Date

Payment Plan 1: Fees are payable in advance in two (2) equal instalments on September 1st and January 15th. Invoices will be mailed in August and December. A post-dated cheque for January must be submitted with the September payment. See the payment plan by grade for more information on the exact amounts.

Payment Plan 2: Fees are payable in ten (10) equal instalments from September 1st to June 1st inclusively, using the Pre-Authorized Payment system. Interest at the rate of 8% is calculated on the outstanding balance of the fees. See the payment plan by grade for more information on the exact amounts.

Exception: The lease-to-purchase option is payable when the laptop is picked up.

Late Payment

Overdue accounts are subject to a late payment fee of 1.5% per month (18% per annum).

Registration Fee

A registration fee of \$200 will be levied each spring prior to a new academic year. This amount will be applied to reduce the June 30th billing of the new academic year (see Sundries).

Technology Fee

Every grade 7-11 student will have the use of a School's laptop during the school year as part of the laptop programme and will be charged \$300 for a technology fee (\$200 to Pre-U students with a personal laptop). The use of a School laptop is not compulsory for Pre-U students. Once a School's laptop is leased-to-purchase, only the technology fee will be charged in the subsequent years.

New Parents Fund

New parents, on acceptance to grades K-11, are invited to make a one time per family voluntary contribution of \$2,000 (\$500 for Pre-U) to this fund dedicated to the improvement of our facilities. A donation receipt will be issued.

Child Care Expenses

In 2005, the School was advised by Revenue Quebec not to issue Relevé 24s for Middle and Senior School students, since they consider that the lunch-time supervision does not constitute Child Care Expenses. Unless advised otherwise by Revenue Quebec, the School will only issue Relevé 24s for the Junior School students: the estimated amount is \$700 per child and is included in the total fees.

Additional Tuition For non-Canadians

(Grade 7-11 only): Under the regulation of the Ministère de l'Éducation, du Loisir et du Sport du Québec (MELS) regarding students not born in Canada who are attending a MELS grant-taking school in Quebec, parents must provide proof that the student is either a Canadian citizen, has his/her permanent residence in Quebec, or is in the care of someone working under specific criteria in Quebec. Failure to have such documented proof means that the School's grant from the MELS will be reduced by \$4,047 for that student. The School is authorized by the MELS to assess the family that charge in addition to the school fees for that student for each year that the School receives grants from the MELS. This amount is subject to an annual increase.

Sundries

An account for sundries will be billed December 15th, April 15th, and June 30th (e.g., LCC Store, Book Room, stationery and workbooks, photographs, student trips, music fee, yearbook, misc., etc.)

Rented Textbooks (Hard Cover)

Rented textbooks (included in Supplementary Fees) not returned by Founder's Day will be billed to your child's account. No credit note will be issued for books returned after that date since the replacement books will have been ordered. In addition, a penalty of \$25.00 will be charged if the book is not returned the day of the exam for Middle School and Senior School students. Starting in 2011-2012, the School will outsource the purchasing of workbooks and softcover books to CSBE. Parents will be asked to order the books they need on-line. The hardcover books will gradually be purchased the same way.

Yearbook

A fee for one yearbook will be charged to every family (not student). This fee of approximately \$80 will vary according to printing costs.

Food Service

A charge of \$1,200 is included from Kindergarten to grade 11 to cover the compulsory lunch and snack service.

Music Fee

An additional fee of \$100 will be billed to all grade 7 students for the use of musical instruments. Students in grades 8 to Pre-U who are enrolled in the music program will be billed \$150.

Additional Services

Extended-Day Programme

Our optional Extended-Day programme offers a safe, fun after-school alternative for students in grades K-6. Parents may pick up their children as late as 6 pm. The annual fee is approximately \$2,160. Part-time participation is permissible and special arrangements can be made. An application form and further details can be obtained through the Admission Office.

Bus Transportation

Private bus transportation is available to families whose children live in certain communities on the island of Montreal. The monthly fee of \$205 is payable to the bus company directly. An application form and further details can be obtained through the Admission Office.

Supplementary Activity Programme (K - 6)

Students in grades K-6 may participate in a supplementary after school activity programme. Activities are determined each term. Applications and further details can be obtained from the Junior School Office.
