



KINDERGARTEN CURRICULUM

Kindergarten at LCC is an exciting, enriching experience. It is a time for exploration, self-discovery and the development of independence.

Our curriculum supports a hands-on, cooperative learning experience. The children will acquire a variety of social, emotional and academic lessons through play, independent work, and group learning activities. These experiences will encourage them to develop a love of school and learning.

English Language Arts

The kindergarten language arts program is designed to be an engaging, activity-based curriculum that supports children in their development as literate individuals. The children are guided and encouraged through multiple teaching-learning contexts including directed instruction, activity centres and individualized instruction.

The children will acquire concepts about the alphabet, letter-sound correspondence and print. Through language-based activities such as stories, songs and poems, the children will develop both phonological and phonemic awareness, and learn sight-words that will support their development as readers and writers.

Mathematics

The kindergarten math curriculum is a hands-on, activity-based program designed to support the children's development of conceptual knowledge of mathematics. Through learning games and centres, the children are exposed to mathematical concepts, tools, and vocabulary that will foster learning of number knowledge and support both oral and symbolic understanding.

French Language Arts

Par le biais de différentes méthodes d'apprentissage (jeux, chansons, causerie, présentations orales, histoires, pièce de théâtre, etc.) et un programme qui cible la pré-lecture et la pré-écriture, les enfants s'engagent progressivement à la maîtrise du français. Ces activités ont aussi pour but de cultiver une attitude positive face à la langue. L'objectif ultime est de maîtriser suffisamment le français à la fin de la maternelle en vue de poursuivre avec aisance en première année.

Science, music and art are integrated into our English and French curriculum through theme-based activities and projects.

Physical Education is taught four times a week in French by our physical education specialists.
