

A WARM, SAFE & WELCOMING ENVIRONMENT

At the very heart of LCC's philosophy is the creation of an atmosphere in which each child can thrive. Since children of different age groups have their own abilities and needs, LCC is divided into four distinct divisions, each with its own physical space and small class sizes, ensuring the academic, social, emotional and physical development of the students.

A PIVOTAL TIME OF ACADEMIC & SOCIAL DEVELOPMENT

Together, the Middle and Senior Schools represent the high school experience at LCC. The program — both academic and co-curricular — is designed according to the age and stage of development of the child, allowing teachers to address the individual needs of the learner.

The Middle School years are an integral link between the Junior and Senior Schools and are rich with opportunities for academic, intellectual and personal growth. Students are encouraged to think creatively, take intellectual risks, and reflect on their own learning styles as they become independent and motivated learners.

The Senior School is a stimulating environment, full of academic challenge, as well as leadership opportunities and athletic and social activities. Students are preparing not only for their future studies but also for lives as passionate and engaged members of society.

THE LCC ADVANTAGE

DEVELOPING A LIFELONG LEARNER

Our goal is to inspire students to become inquiring, principled, open-minded, reflective and engaged citizens of our world. The rigorous academic program is designed to help students of all ages think critically, communicate effectively, problem-solve creatively, study independently and apply their knowledge in a variety of situations.

The Middle School academic program is diverse and challenging. The extensive core program includes English, math, science and the social sciences, and students enhance their language skills with core courses in French. In grade 8, they also learn Spanish. Technology is integrated into the program through grade-wide learning activities that are guided by IT specialists. All Middle School students are exposed to the arts through the study of music and visual art in grade 7, and they may study music in grade 8 or take art and drama courses.

The Senior School is designed to develop well-rounded students — enthusiastic learners and citizens who are ready to meet the challenges of university. The core subjects are wide-ranging and students may also choose courses of personal interest as they continue through the program. Grade 9 students continue with Spanish and can select between three optional courses in the arts — music, drama or visual art. In grade 10, we expand the number of options to encourage students to continue in an artistic discipline or explore a different course, such as design and innovation or computer programming.

The grade 11 program contains even more choice and options. In addition to completing the Quebec High School Diploma, students can pursue Year 1 of the two-year International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme. All students select three optional courses from a wide list of offerings to prepare them for the arts, sciences, business or other potential fields of study.

OUR ACADEMIC DIFFERENTIATORS

INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE DIPLOMA PROGRAMME (IBDP)

LCC is the only English high school in Montreal to offer the IBDP where the focus is on an academically challenging, international education. Taught over a two-year period (grades 11 and 12) the IBDP positions students for direct entrance to university anywhere in the world.

LEAD (LEARNING ENRICHMENT AND DEVELOPMENT)

We understand that students are unique with varied learning styles and we cater to those differences with a variety of teaching approaches. Using research-based educational practices, the LEAD Centre supports the diverse learners in LCC's community in order to facilitate academic success.

EXECUTIVE FUNCTIONING PROGRAM

We want students to be prepared for their future, and central to this preparation is the development of Executive Functioning (EF) skills. Our EF program is designed to help students develop their organizational and learning skills and understand how they learn best.

PRE-UNIVERSITY: GRADE 12 PROGRAM

Unique to LCC is its Pre-University: Grade 12 program, which offers an enriched curriculum and personalized academic counselling. The quality and scope of the one-year program provide sound preparation for university entrance worldwide, including Quebec. Pre-U also fosters responsibility, perseverance and leadership that will serve the graduate throughout university and into professional life.

INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE MIDDLE YEARS PROGRAMME (IB MYP)

LCC has been approved as a candidate school for the IB MYP. This is the first step in becoming an authorized MYP school and further validates our approaches to teaching and learning. Authorization is expected by summer 2020.

TEACHERS WHO EMPOWER & INSPIRE

With an unwavering dedication to their craft, expertise in a variety of domains, and real-world experience, our teachers ensure a rewarding student experience. They are committed to continuous improvement and pursue professional development activities to enhance their teaching skills and acquire new knowledge.

STUDENT HEALTH & WELLNESS

Our priority is to support the physical, mental, social and emotional growth of our students to ensure that they feel safe and happy in their environment. They are surrounded by faculty and staff who truly get to know them. Our team of grade supervisors, division directors, coaches, school and academic counsellors, and onsite nurse provide ongoing support to students, as do their advisors who serve as advocates and mentors. Students meet regularly in advisory groups to discuss issues such as goal setting and performance.

SCHOLARSHIPS & FINANCIAL AID

We believe that all students should have access to an LCC education regardless of their financial circumstances and offer assistance to qualified students in grades 7 – 12 who have a demonstrated need.

ELIGIBILITY

In the province of Quebec, access to English schooling is governed by the provisions in Bill 115. This means that English schools receiving grants from the government can only accept students who have English eligibility. LCC's elementary school does not receive government grants but does receive partial funding for its high school. Contact the Admissions Office for more information.
